There are a lot of headlines from the Governor's new Emergency Order, to the

new programs that are being launched by the state to help small businesses, to trick or treating so let's get to it!

The New Emergency Order #3 from Governor Evers takes effect on October 8th through November 6th, 2020.

Yesterday, we received a communique from the State Department of Tourism and the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation announcing some new programs. The **We're All In Grants Phase II** will be geared towards businesses that may have not been eligible for the first go around, or didn't receive a grant from the phase I grant.

Governor Tony Evers doubled down on his commitment to Wisconsin's tourism economy by announcing approximately \$100 million in new grants largely targeted at Wisconsin's tourism industry. We will forward information as soon as we receive it to the business community! This is sure to be welcoming news to small businesses!
