They accomplish this goal while providing quality outdoor products and exceptional customer service to keep their clientele on the move, whether they hike, bike, paddle, run, ski, walk or camp.

Originally from Ashland, store owner Katie Gellatly returned to the area in 2001 to work at Northland College. Ten years later, she and her husband Dave opened Solstice Outdoors in downtown Ashland. They saw the business as an "opportunity to contribute to the vitality of the community by offering residents www.solsticeoutdoorstore.com and visitors to the area a place to find quality outdoor-inspired clothing and gear that you just can't find in the region."

Since moving into their spacious new digs in 2015 inside the stunning Blue Wave on the Bay building adjacent to Maslowski Beach, Solstice Outdoors has become Cheguamegon Bay's outdoor recreation center where visitors and locals alike have turned out in large numbers to rent a paddleboard, bike, kayak, skis or snowshoes to explore our area.

"Over 50% of our kayak and paddleboard rentals last year were local residents taking advantage of the affordable rates we offer," Katie noted. "We want to get people out there and help them realize there is so much to do right here in Ashland."

She also wanted folks to know that they sell their rental kayaks at the end of the season so people can get a great deal on an awesome watercraft.

"We have been able to expand our camping gear selection at the new store," Katie added. "You can get pretty much everything you need to outfit your trip and we have gear for world travelers as well like water filtration systems. So even if you're heading to Costa Rica, you can get the gear you need right here."

Looking ahead to the 2016 summer season, Katie said Solstice Outdoors will offer drop-in classes as well as guided estuary kayak tours with an emphasis on learning about local flora and fauna.
