


12 Kilometers of ski trails for public use near Memorial Medical Center, Donations are suggested.

RV Camping ONLY (33 Sites), Boat launch, ARTS access, sump station, pavilion, playground and beach all available to the public. No lifeguard on duty.


The Ashland Oredock



This unique park is the base of the historic Soo Line Oredock, extending 1800' (almost a 1/4 mile) out into Lake Superior. Here you can imagine ore boats tied up awaiting a shipment of coal from a superstructure 80' tall. ADA compliant, accessible via the ARTS. Open to fishing and bird watching.
