Ashland County offers some of the finest fishing in the Midwest, home to over 300 miles of Class "A" trout streams and 85 lakes including the largest freshwater body in the world - Lake Superior. A majority of Lake Superior's Apostle Islands are located in the northern part of Ashland County and offer some of

the best lake trout, brown trout and salmon fishing on the Great Lakes.

• Lake Superior's Cheguamegon Bay - Year 'Round Fishing

Offering a diverse fishery that attracts anglers yearly from all over the United States. In Fisherman magazine voted Chequamegon Bay as one of the Top Ten Destinations for smallmouth bass in the world. For smallmouth bass, Chequamegon Bay is primarily a catch-and-release fishery and managed for trophy smallmouth with a minimum size limit of 22". The average size smallmouth is greater than 18" and 50-100-fish days are not uncommon, regardless of the time of year. Chequamegon Bay is also known

for trophy walleye, northern pike, perch, trout, salmon and whitefish, which are the most sought-after species on the bay, offering something for all anglers.

Inland Lakes and Streams

Our inland lakes and streams offer some excellent fishing for muskies, walleye, bass, northern pike, perch, panfish and trout. The streams and rivers flowing into Lake Superior are some of the finest trout and salmon fishing you will find anywhere.
