In order to participate in any Wisconsin vending event, a Wisconsin Seller's Permit is needed. (see attached form).

Ashland Bay Days on main will be held on Historic Main Street from the 100 block to the 800 block of West Main Street. Friday events include: Sidewalk Sales, music, food, chalk event, and more. Saturday is the big day with all sorts of family fun activities! Cornhole Tournament, Sidewalk Sales, Strongest Man on the Bay, Strongest BAM-BAM on the Bay, Bay Days Fun Run 1-mile/5K/10K, Petting Zoo, Pie Eating Contest, Baby Crawl, Toddler Run, Sportsman for God Kids Activities, and Car Show. Topping the evening off is the All-School Reunion Street Dance. Watch for other surprises to this year's event!

## **Eligibility**

- Arts & Vendors: products that are handmade by the vendor; paintings, sculptures, pottery, and photography. (No food or drink sales allowed.)
- Information: non-profit organizations, educational institutions, clubs and civic groups. (No food or drink sales allowed.)
- Retail: commercial business/retail sales. Products that are not handmade by the vendor. (No food or drink sales allowed.)

## **Festival Rules**

- The basic vendor fee is due with application. An invoice will be sent to those requesting additional booth space footage.
- No spaces will be assigned or held without payment. If you are not accepted into the festival, payment will be returned.
- Vending hours: July 18, from 10am-7pm and July 19, 9 am-6pm. Please list what time you would like to arrive to set-up.

- Registration fees will not be refunded due to undesirable weather.
- Bay Days is an outdoor event. Vendors are responsible for providing their own tables, chairs, tent, etc.
- No Food or Beverages can be sold by arts & vendors, retail vendors, or information booths.
- Electricity will not be available to arts & vendors.
- The vendor is entirely responsible for the leased space and shall keep it free from any conditions which might be dangerous.
- For safety reasons, no cooking will be permitted outside the
  designated booth space. Booth clean-up and garbage removal is
  the responsibility of the vendor during and after the festival. A \$50
  fine will be levied against any vendor who does not remove their
  garbage during and after the festival. No vendor or representative
  shall conduct him/herself in a manner offensive to standards of
  decency or good taste.

## **Cancellation Policy:**

If you cancel by June 10, you will receive a 75% refund. After June 10, no refund. For lowest rate return application before June 3
