Eligibility

- **Arts & Crafts:** products that are handmade crafts by the vendor; paintings, sculptures, pottery, and photography. (No food or drink sales allowed.)
- **Information:** non-profit organizations, educational institutions, clubs and civic groups. (No food or drink sales allowed.)
- **Retail:** commercial business/retail sales. Products that are not handmade by the vendor. (No food or drink sales allowed.)

Festival Rules

- The basic vendor fee is due with application. An invoice will be sent to those requesting additional booth space footage.
 - No spaces will be assigned or held without payment. If you are not accepted into the festival, payment will be returned.
 - **Vending hours: July 14, from 10am –8pm and July 15, 9 am-6pm. Please list what time you would like to arrive to set-up.**
- Note: Due to the street reopening on Friday evening, after the Battle of the Bands all vendors must remove their booths on Friday evening by 8pm and reset on Saturday.**

- Registration fees will not be refunded due to undesirable weather.
- Bay Days is an outdoor event. Vendors are responsible for providing their own tables, chairs, etc.
- No Food or Beverages can be sold by arts & crafts vendors, retail vendors, or information booths.
- Electricity will not be available to craft vendors.
- The vendor is entirely responsible for the leased space and shall keep it free from any conditions which might be dangerous.
- For safety reasons, no cooking will be permitted outside the designated booth space. Booth clean-up and garbage removal is the responsibility of the vendor during and after the festival. A \$50 fine will be levied against any vendor who does not remove their garbage during and after the festival. No vendor or representative shall conduct him/herself in a manner offensive to standards of decency or good taste.

Cancellation Policy:

If you cancel by June 9, you will receive a 75% refund. After June 9, no refund. For lowest rate return application before June 1
